

PADDOCK CONTROL FOR HALTER CLASSES

One specified person assisting with entrance of in-hand horses into the ring will be allowed to use only the same length whip and appendages as are currently allowed for the individual handling the horse. Whips are to be no longer than 6' including snapper/lash/appendage. Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted. Rule AR114.2 The designated person will not hit or use any other objects, such as trash cans, walls, etc. to make any noise. In addition, effective immediately, the use of plastic or paper bags of any type or size is prohibited in assisting with the entrance(s) into the arena.

REGION III QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

Horses must be issued a Certificate of Registration from the Arabian Horse Association, the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or the Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registrar and OWNED BY A MEMBER OF THE ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION. Horses must be qualified in an AHA Recognized show/division that was held within the preceding calendar year and that period of the current year to the final deadline of entries of the show in which the Regional Championship is held.

Horses must be qualified at an AHA Recognized show/division held within Region III area for the Regional Championship class(s) to be entered. All horses entering any Regional Amateur Owner (AO, AAO, JO) Championship class must have been qualified by an Amateur Owner. It is the responsibility of the Amateur Owner to abide by this rule. All horses entering any Regional Amateur (ATR, AATR, JTR) Championship class must have been qualified by an Amateur. It is the responsibility of the Amateur to abide by this rule.

REGIONAL QUALIFICATION RULES

See AHA Handbook Chapter 11, 12 & 13. The points/score listed on the National Class List for Regional classes must be obtained in the same AHA Section listed in the AHA Standard Class List. The Point System as reflected on the National Class List is implemented for all Regional classes. The number of points a horse receives is based on the number of horses shown and judged. Horses will earn one point for every horse in the class. Regional Top Five, Champion or Reserve Champion does not qualify a horse for a Regional Championship Class. Points, scores or placing from shows other than Regional shows will count for Regional shows. Points for qualifications will be awarded to horses placing first thru sixth only. In addition to points, Regional Shows allow qualifications by earning one first place or one second place.

TRAIL USING SCORES – Horse must be qualified at an AHA Recognized show/division for the Regional Championship class(s) entered. Trail horses MAY use ONE score of 68 or better to qualify or one point.

<u>WORKING COW USING SCORES</u> – Horse must be qualified at an AHA or NRCHA Recognized show/division for the Regional Championship class(s) entered. Working cow MAY use ONE score of 68 or better to qualify or one point.

REINING USING SCORES – Horse must be qualified at an AHA Recognized show/division or NRHA Sanctioned Class for the Regional Championship class(s) entered. Reining horses MAY use ONE score of 68 or better to qualify or one point.

AWARDS - A Champion and Reserve Champion plus three additional unranked awards shall be made in each Regional Class to make a Top Five. Region III Championship Show will give a FULL TOP FIVE awards to each class regardless of the number of entries in the class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA Horse Achievement Award, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Award, High Point Amateur Achievement Award and Distance Award Points.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES -- Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes Allocated prize money is available at each 2016 Regional Championship Horse Show. Requests for any refunds due to the illness or injury of the exhibitor MUST be in writing, accompanied by a Veterinarian certificate or Doctors note, and MUST be received by the show secretary PRIOR to the start of the said show. On approved refund requests, ONLY class fees will be refunded with 25% of class fees retained for processing. NO refunds will be made on drug fees, office fees, etc. Refunds on stall or tack room fees will NOT be made after June 30th. Resolution 9-90 fees will be refunded to the exhibitor of a horse which is vetted out of a show before the show begins, is not on the grounds and is in compliance with the show's vet out policy. All approved refunds if not processed at the show will be mailed within 3 weeks.

Assignment of stalls will be made as fairly as possible on the basis of many considerations, including show support, time of receipt of entries, number of horses, show decor, ring use, etc. We ask your cooperation in these assignments. If you have special requests or considerations, please submit them with your entry. All requests will be considered but no promises can be made. BE ADVISED: Regarding horses that are entered after closing date of entries, June 6th, or post entered late and request stabling with other horses previously entered, original stalling assignments WILL NOT be changed to accommodate the late entry. Management will try to stable late entries AS CLOSE AS POSSIBLE to other entries but NO GUARANTEES can be made. Show management's decision is final.

TYPES OF STALLS

MD STALLS – There are 379 PERMANENT 10 X 12 metal stalls with bars on upper front and upper top of stall door available. Electric outlets and water are located at convenient locations.

<u>PORTABLE STALLS</u> – There are over 500 portable stalls available on the grounds. These stalls are canvas stalls with bars on upper front and upper top of stall doors and have canvas roofs. Stalls are lighted and water is close to each barn.

WASH RACKS - Concrete wash racks are located in several locations close to stable areas.



AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT - EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITION. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND THE AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT THE AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT THE AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

Copies of ALL trainers, drivers, riders and handlers and at least ONE Owner's current AHA Competition Membership Cards MUST be included with the horse show entry form at the time of entry.

<u>REGION III CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW</u> - CURRENT COMPETITION MEMBERSHIP IN AHA IS A REQUIREMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE REGION III CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW.

<u>US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION STATEMENT</u> - Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) lead line; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

<u>USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS</u> - Copies of every owner's, trainer's, rider's, driver's and breeding/Inhand halter handler's current USEF Membership Cards MUST be included with the horse show entry form at the time of entry. A non-member, who wishes to participate as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at a Regular Competitions must pay a Show Pass Fee for each competition in which competing. Lessees are considered owners in connection with this membership requirement. In the event of multiple ownership of a horse, only one owner need be a Member or pay a Show Pass Fee. The amount of the Show Pass fee will be established annually by the Federation. Unless otherwise established, the fee will be \$30.00 and must be collected by all appropriate competitions and remitted to the Federation. Senior Active Member are those Members who are at least 18 years of age. Their annual dues are \$55.00. Junior Active Members are those Members who have not reached their 18th birthday as provided for in GR127. Their annual dues at \$55.00

<u>USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION</u> – Only active Federation members may obtain amateur status. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur status issued by the Federation. There is no additional fee for amateur status for Senior Active or Life Members. Such status will expire on November 30th.

ACHIEVEMENT AWARD POINTS — This show is recognized by the AHA enabling exhibitors to receive Achievement Award Points in all USEF approved classes.

ADMISSION TO RING - No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, judges, show officials and their assistants. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED in any class requiring grooms or assistants to enter the ring,

AGE OF HORSES - For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. A JUNIOR horse is one that is 5 years old and under.

AMATEUR OWNER FAMILY DEFINITION - An Amateur Owner Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider, driver or handler is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family. "Family" includes husband, wife, parent, stepparent, child, brother, stepchild, sister, half-brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandmother, grandfather and in-laws of the same relation as stated. Combined ownership is NOT permitted in Amateur/Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. LEASED horses are NOT eligible.

ARENA DIMENSIONS AND FOOTING – Main Arena #1 is 121' X 255' and covered. Arena #3 is 100' X 235' and covered. Stable Mix Arena #4 is 105' X 240' and covered. Finish Line Arena #7 is 105' X 250' and covered. The footing in all arenas is high performance sand mixture.

CENTER RING

No one is allowed in the center ring except judges, officials and staff. When arena is open for schooling of horses, the center ring area (including tables, couches, chairs, etc) is closed to all exhibitors, trainers, friends and family.

CLASS CONFLICTS

EXHIBITORS ARE CAUTIONED AGAINST ENTERING THE SAME HORSE IN SUCCESSIVE CLASSES OR TWO RINGS AT SAME TIME. DUE TO FULL SCHEDULES, GATES WILL NOT BE HELD FOR RIDERS WITH CONFLICTING SCHEDULES IN TWO RINGS. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR RING CONFLICTS OR CLASS CONFLICTS. PLAN YOUR CLASS SCHEDULE VERY CAREFULLY.

CONDITION OF ENTRIES - All entries, except entries in equitation and showmanship classes must be serviceably sound. All horses must be in good condition. Horses with loss of sight in one eye may compete in any class except Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes and Sport Horse In-Hand Classes. No horse may compete in a class in the Arabian Division with a tail carriage that has been altered in any manner or by any means. Violations of this rule are considered serious infractions, because such alterations constitute misrepresentation of the breed type. No horse may compete in a class in the Arabian Division with any chemical or other Irritant of any kind present on its anus, vulva, rectal area or vaginal area, regardless of the origin of the irritant and whether it was applied or its presence resulted from dietary, environmental or unknown origins, and whether the horse's tail carriage was affected by its presence. Any action against the horse by an exhibitor, which are deemed excessive by a judge, Federation steward or competition veterinarian, in the competition ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the show committee. Such action could include, but are not limited to excessive use of whip, spurs or bamboo poles. Judges must eliminate from judging consideration any horse which shows aggression or discontent toward its handler, rider or any person in the ring. A judged must order from the ring any rider, driver or handler who exhibits inappropriate or dangerous behavior or whose actions would in any way threaten the safety of the exhibitor, their entries or the safety of class officials. Horses showing signs of undue stress or inhumane treatment must be penalized. The exhibition of a horse that has a cut or abrasion showing clear evidence of fresh blood in the mouth, nose, chin, shoulder, barrel, flank or hip area must be considered to be ineligible to receive an award in that respective class. Judges must excuse from the ring any horse that possesses a whip mark (welt) on any portion of the horse.

CRUELTY AND ABUSE - USEF GR839 & AR105 WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AT ALL AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITIONS.

DISCIPLINE - Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, handler or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, handler or driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

DISQUALIFICATION - Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show ring will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing, or exhibiting. In case any animal is disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified animal and the lowest moneyed prize in the class shall go to the reserve number.

DOGS - Dogs may be brought onto the show grounds, but must be on a leash at all times. Dogs will not be allowed in ARENAS, REST ROOMS and OFFICES. Dog owners MUST clean up after their dogs. Dogs left unattended in the barn area, RV parking area, parking lot, etc. that BARK and/or DISTURB other exhibitors or guests will be asked to be removed from the grounds. Please keep dogs under control at all times and be considerate of others.

DRUGS & MEDICATIONS – Horses at recognized competitions are subject to examination, which may include physical, saliva, urine or blood tests or any other test or procedure at the direction of said license tester. The exhibitor must file an official Equine Drugs & Medications Report Form with the Show Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative within one hour after administration or one hour after the Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative returns to duty if administration is at a time other than during competition hours. The official Drugs and Medication Report Form is available from the officiating Show Steward or Designated Competition Representative.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES — Electronic communication devices used for the purpose of coaching, etc. between competitors and individuals outside the ring, shall be prohibited in all classes in the Arabian Division. Handicapped riders who have submitted written proof to the USEF Steward are exempt from rule.

FARRIER - The show farrier will be available on the show grounds during all scheduled sessions located close to Main Arena. The show farrier will also be available Thursday 7/6 approximately 9:00 a.m.

GATE RULE - Due to a <u>full</u> schedule of classes, the TWO-MINUTE limit after last call for a class will be STRICTLY enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes or rings. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes, at the completion of the final horse in the continuous string of horses. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. <u>CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY</u>. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction.

HALF ARABIAN / ANGLO ARABIAN COLTS/STALLIONS – Half Arabian and Anglo Arabian stallions registered with AHA or have been issued an AHA (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registrar) CPAR Permit are permitted to compete in the AHA performance classes for Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses. Half Arabian and Anglo-Arabian stallions may compete in their corresponding Sport horse In Hand Classes and may compete in Sport Horse performance classes for Half Arabian & Anglo-Arabian horses. Half-Arabian & Anglo-Arabian colts/stallions may compete in weanling and yearling Breeding/ In–Hand classes for geldings and in Sport Horse In Hand classes.

HEADGEAR – All juniors riding in Hunter, Jumper and Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling & exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is property in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEA) in any division or class without penalty from the judge.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS - Every horse entered in the show will be assigned an identification number. For proper handling of the show, the riders, drivers and handlers must wear the correct number in all classes.

<u>JUDGES</u> - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize list. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES - All entries are accepted with the understanding that REGION III of AHA and the MURIETA EQUESTRIAN CENTER, MEC, Cosumnes Corporation, West Coast Equine Foundation, their corporate owners, officers, agents, servants, landlord, and employees will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify REGION III of AHA and the MURIETA EQUESTRIAN CENTER, against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing the same of the provisions herein set forth.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER FOR MURIETA EQUESTRIAN CENTER

All exhibitors entering the Region III Arabian Championship Show held at Murieta Equestrian Center agree to the following: "I hereby RELEASE and agree to DEFEND INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS MEC, Cosumnes Corporation, West Coast Equine Foundation, their shareholders, officers, employees, agents, instructors, equipment manufacturers, lessors, and the insurers (hereinafter collectively referred to a "Parties Released"), from and against any liability, demand, claim, or right of action for any damage or injury, including paralysis or death, to any person or property, even if such damage or personal injury results from the NEGLIGENCE of MEC or their Parties Released. I further COVENANT NOT TO SUE or make any demand or claim against MEC or other Parties Released, for or by reason of any such damage or personal injury from my participation in equestrian activities at MEC. I will pay for all fees, damages, and costs, including attorney fees that MEC or other Parties Released may incur in the enforcement of this agreement."

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS - To be eligible, riders must not have reached their 19th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1st assume the greater age on that date. Junior exhibitors (18 year olds) will have to take out an adult membership with USEF and they must declare if they are an amateur or pro as defined by USEF. If they fall under the definition of a pro, then they can no longer compete in the Junior exhibitor classes since they are no longer considered amateurs according to GR106, even though they are still by AHA definition a Junior exhibitor.

MAIDEN, NOVICE AND LIMIT CLASSES - Maiden, Novice & Limit classes are open to horses which have not won one/three/six first place ribbons respectively, at Regular Member Competitions of USEF or CEF in the particular performance division in which they are shown. For this show, a Maiden, Novice or Limit Horse/Rider is as of the closing date of entries (JUNE 7th)

MOTORIZED VEHICLES (Golf Carts, Mopeds, 3-Wheel Vehicles, Mini Bikes)

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the sate in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from the rule.

REMEMBER – HORSES ALWAYS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR HORSES

ARABIAN HORSES--Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or if less than one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers).

<u>HALF ARABIAN / ANGLO ARABIAN HORSES</u> - Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have been issued an Arabian Horse Association (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registrar) CPAR Permit; or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry & registration applied for and be entered under their full registered name

<u>HORSES SHOWING IN AMATEUR/OWNER CLASSES</u> - Horses entered in an Amateur Owner or Junior Owner class MUST be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family (as defined by USEF GR123). Horses registered in a farm/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contract or Bill of Sale will NOT be accepted.

REGISTRATION PAPERS REQUIRED - A copy of the current registration papers showing proof of ownership (front & back of old papers; front of new papers) MUST be submitted with the entry form at the time of making an entry. The copies will be returned in your show packet.

RULES - This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Equestrian Federation, Chapter AR - Arabian, Half-Arabian & Anglo-Arabian Division. The official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for the knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted & judged in accordance therewith. The Show Committee shall decide questions that are not addressed by USEF Rules and their decision is final.

<u>SCRATCHING OR CANCELING CLASSES</u> - As a courtesy to the gateman, announcer & show office, the exhibitors are <u>requested</u> to notify the gateman & show office when it is necessary to scratch or cancel a class entered. This courtesy will enable the show to run more efficiently. Your consideration is appreciated!

STALLIONS - Ladies and junior exhibitors in any class in this show may show Arabian stallions except Showmanship, Walk Trot and Lead Line. Unruly horses in any class will be promptly dismissed.

<u>VETERINARIAN</u> - A veterinarian will be present throughout the show & will be available on the grounds during all scheduled sessions. The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease. No veterinarian other than the official show veterinarian will be permitted to treat, medicate, or attend to a horse on the grounds. Anyone wishing to use another veterinarian other than the official Show Veterinarian on the grounds must obtain permission from Show Management.

EQUINE VACCINATION RULE - New 2016

- 1. At Federation (USEF) licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus & Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
- 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
- 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration
- 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letter-head stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
